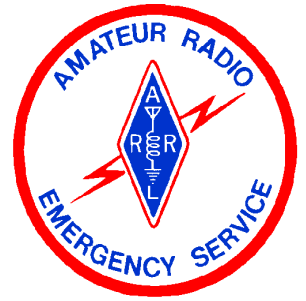

BARC 2018 Dues Now Payable

BARC Treasurer Paul Sharp KD8OPN has announced that he now is accepting dues for 2018.

Most BARC memberships expire December 31, 2017.

- Free memberships for hams newly licensed in 2017 expire 12 months from the end of the month first licensed.
- Free memberships for new hams licensed in November or December 2017 are good through December 31, 2018.
- New members joining BARC in November or December 2017 pay \$15 which includes 2018 dues.
- Annual membership renewal is \$15 per member and \$3 for each additional family member living at the same address.
- BARC members first licensed in 2017 who elected free membership will be notified by the Treasurer of their free membership expiration date. Such members will pay a pro-rated amount of dues for the 2018 membership year.
- 2017 memberships become delinquent if not renewed by the February 2018 meeting. The 2018 Membership Directory will include all members who have renewed or joined by 1 March 2018.

Dues help support Club activities such as the Clubhouse, the Communications Center, Field Day expenses, the Repeaters, and other purchases and activities as approved by the Club during the year.

The Meeting was called to order at 7:34 by the President.

Recent Equipment Donation to BARC. Fair Market Value for the equipment was estimated. The club has identified three items to retain and will sell the balance. Two items already have potential buyers. Members will be offered the equipment 1st.

Repeaters. Noise was noted on the repeater during the Sunday Evening BARC Net. It was suggested that a systems engineering approach should be applied to troubleshoot the problem. Installation of the 6-m repeater is pending.

Clubhouse Emergency Lighting. Installation of the emergency egress light is pending.

Education. The digital mode study group has been cancelled. Paul Sharp needs an estimate for new

hams joining BARC after the Fall Greene County testing prior to purchasing complementary HT's.

Repeater hardline. Ken Moak has the hardline in hand. The wiring interface is being studied. Ken will interface with Russ for delivery.

Ohio State Parks on the Air (OSPOTA). Ken Moak reports that the official scores have not yet been released.

CQWW SSB Contest. Ken Moak reports that scores are pending. The BARC stations performed well with no issues.

Tower Climbers. The club is seeking additional tower climbers to reduce the burden on Chris Stauter, who is currently the Club's sole climber. Club member Emerio Ordoñez TG9AZB is a candidate for this function.

Nominations Committee. The Nominating Committee for the election of the 2018 BARC officers and Members-at-Large has identified nominees for all positions. The committee chair will announce the nominees at the November general membership meeting. Additional nominations may be made from the floor at the November meeting; after which the nomination process will close. Elections will be held at the December meeting.

Treasurer's Report. Paul Sharp announced that 2018 BARC dues are payable. He also presented the current financial report.

BARC Member Activities. Mel Metzler recommends the following BARC member activities:

- BARC station tutorial for new hams.
- Tours of members' personal ham shacks
- Antenna raising parties.

Fort Wayne IN Ham Fest: November 18-19, 2017

Station Hardware Integration.

- Ken Moak reports that that the 300-ft of repeater hardline is in hand but needs to be cut from the spool. Connectors are also in-hand. The half inch hardline for the clubhouse station use is presently at the repeater site and need to be transported ASAP. It should be placed within the fenced area adjacent to the clubhouse.
- 160 m antenna and radials are cut; the matching network need to be built; completion expected by ARRL Sweepstakes weekend.
- An additional feedline need to be run for the 80/60/40 antenna.
- Ken will approach Lynn Rogers about making brackets for the VHF antennas and the future 6-m repeater antenna.

- An ICOM power "T" connector is needed in order to complete the clubhouse station set-up.
- The crimped coax connectors to the Polyphasers and patch panel need to be replaced.
- Feedline installation to front of clubhouse for presentations and demonstrations is pending.
- Request that Dave Walton KD8GCR, our W8DGN trustee, appropriately register the club for VLF work.

Membership Registration Form. Paul Sharp noted some needed changes that were made to the BARC membership registration form.

Adjournment. The president adjourned the meeting at 8:13 PM.
