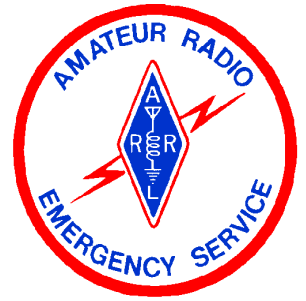

BARC 2018 Dues Now Payable

BARC Treasurer Paul Sharp KD8OPN has announced that he is now accepting dues for 2018.

Most BARC memberships expire December 31, 2017.

- Annual membership renewal is \$15 per member and \$3 for each additional family member living at the same address.
- New members joining BARC in November or December 2017 pay \$15 which includes 2018 dues.
- Free memberships for hams newly licensed in 2017 expire 12 months from the end of the month first licensed.
- BARC members first licensed in 2017 who elected free membership will be notified by the Treasurer of their free membership expiration date. Such members will pay a pro-rated amount of dues for the 2018 membership year.
- 2017 memberships become delinquent if not renewed by the February 2018 meeting. The 2018 Membership Directory will include all members who have renewed or joined by 1 March 2018.

The Meeting was called to order at 7:44 by the President.

Station Hardware Integration.

- Ken Moak reports that that the 300-ft of repeater hardline with connectors needs to be transported from his house. Fred Stone reports that there may

be a repeater site installation delay which is outside of BARC's control.

- The half inch hardline for the clubhouse station use is presently at the repeater site and needs to be transported to the clubhouse. It should be placed within the locked fenced area adjacent to the clubhouse.
- Radio at Station #3 now has a power cord and is operational.
- The 160-m antenna is working well.
- A 6-m radio has been donated
- Chris Stauter and Lynn Rogers are working to mount the EMCOMM antennas and a donated Ringo Ranger antenna.
- A project underway to install a 600W amplifier in Station #4. Fred Stone to advise Ken Moak on the wiring details on the Comm Center electrical panel.

BARC Website. Bob French has offered to coordinate the technical aspects of the website. Jim Totten will coordinate the content.

Repeaters. Intermittent noise continues to be a problem on the repeater particularly during the Sunday Evening BARC Net. Jim Totten and Henry Bussey have observed that noise is not observed during the day.

The 6-meter repeater installation is delayed until the two triband antennas are installed at the repeater site. A duplexer might be available as an alternative to separate receive and transmit antennas.

Clubhouse Emergency Lighting. Installation of the emergency egress light is pending. Fred Stone plans to work on the emergency lights tomorrow morning.

Educational Study Groups. Digital Mode Study Group has been delayed. Antenna Study Group is planned for mid-February.

Echo Link/ILRP. Echo Link/IRLP equipment is in-hand but cannot be made operational until internet connectivity issues are resolved at the repeater shack.

Sunday Evening BARC Net. There are typically, 12-18 check-in's.

Ohio State Parks on the Air (OSPOTA). BARC placed third in the state for 2017.

Upcoming Contests. 10m Contest this weekend (Friday and Sunday)

Tower Climbers. The club is seeking additional tower climbers to reduce the burden on Chris Stauter, who is currently the Club's sole climber. Club member Emerio Ordoñez TG9AZB is a candidate for this function.

Nominations Committee. The Nominations for the election of the 2018 BARC officers and Members-at-Large was closed at the November meeting. Elections will be held at the December meeting.

Recent Equipment Donation to BARC. Some equipment has been sold. Potential buyers for some of the other equipment have been identified. Remaining equipment will be sold outside.

Treasurers Report. Paul presented the interim period financial report and announced that 2018 BARC dues are payable.

Fred Stone noted that the Family Membership policy needs to be reviewed and clarified for newly licensed family groups with respect to the first-year free membership or free radio option.

Emergency Communications Coordinator Appointment. President Chris Stauter has announced the appointment of Roger Parrett N8QRP as Emergency Communications Coordinator. Roger will be replacing retiring Fred Stone. His appointment is expected to be confirmed by a vote of the membership at the December General Membership meeting.

BARC Polo and Sweatshirts. Don Parker will make arrangements with Logos-at-Work for a new order.

December Meeting Program. Ken Moak recommended allowing up to 1 hour and 15 minutes (for questions) for December's meeting program
