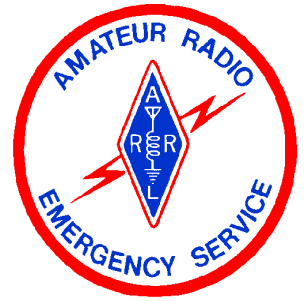

The Meeting was called to order at 7:31 by the President.

Public Service
